





#### What are Concept Books?


- Books designed to teach children about ideas, concepts or issues in their world.
- Usually picture books (though concept books also exist for older kids)
- Primarily non-fiction, and not story-driven though some may have a narrative thread, especially if character-driven
- Alphabet, counting, shapes, colors, opposites, time, How-to books
- Books about nature and science
- Books dealing with specific concerns, such as divorce, moving, a new sibling, travel, surgery
















## What is the Purpose and/or Value of Concept Books?

- Introduce and reinforce concepts like ABCs, numbers, shapes, colors, and feelings.
- Expand children's understanding of an idea, relationship, or theme.
- Provide a starting point for adult-child conversations.
- Connect children's real life experiences to abstract ideas like opposites.
- Explore topics of interest to children in enjoyable ways.
- Help with language development. The pictures help children anchor words to images.
- Teach reading recognition children begin to discover the connection between oral and written language.
- Positive experiences with concept books help prepare a child for becoming a successful reader.


#### Successful Concept Books...


- Teach and entertain at the same time.
- Have an interesting, ifuntraditional, story to tell
- Hook the child reader by using story to introduce a concept
- Build interest and excitement by showing how the concept relates to a child's age/ interest/life
- Rely on/respect the illustrator to tell at least half the story




#### What are Novelty Books?




